**IN THE OFFERING PLATE:** Use the envelopes in the seatback pockets or contact the church office to request a personal supply of giving envelopes.

**AT THE SECURE DROP BOXES:** Four secure drop box locations - in the Commons, in the Fellowship Hallway and in front of the Main Office entrance.



**GIVE ONLINE:** An easy way to give and set up automatic recurring contributions on our secure website. *(see instructions on the back of this card)*

**BY TEXT-TO-GIVE:** Fast, secure and easy way to give from anywhere. *(see instructions on the back of this card)*



**TRANSFER FUNDS OR SECURITIES:** Transfer funds or securities directly from your account to the church's account with UBS Financial Services. *(see instructions on the back of this card)*

## TEXT-TO-GIVE INSTRUCTIONS:



- 1) Create a text message to (239)360-5030.
- 2) Type "Give" in the message field.
- 3) The program will send you to the link to give.
- 4) Click on "<https://my.fbcn.org/give>".
- 5) Click "Give Now".
- 6) Fill out the personal information - then click "Next".
- 7) Fill out the bank or card information and then click "Next".
- 8) Review and click "Finish".

## TRANSFER FUNDS OR SECURITIES INSTRUCTIONS:
